第5問

Tokyo hosted the Summer Olympics in 2020. 11,420 athletes from the 206 countries and teams gathered in the Tokyo Stadium and competed in about 340 events for the gold medals. But how did the Olympics start? Let's look back on its history.

The first Olympic Games started in Greece in 776 B.C. They were athletic competitions held in honor of Zeus, the king of the gods. In those days, there were a lot of wars among the cities in Greece. People held a festival every four years and during the games they stopped the wars so that athletes from different cities could travel safely to and from the games.

At first, the Olympic Games had only one event - a short race across the stadium, but through the years more events were added, such as boxing, wrestling and throwing discs. In the ancient Olympics, only men were allowed to compete. The winners were awarded not a medal but a crown of olive branches. The ancient Olympics continued for about a thousand years. However, it ended because of the Roman Conquest.

Almost 1500 years later, someone tried to hold the Olympics again. A French man, named Coubertin created the International Olympic Committee in 1894, and the first games organized by the IOC took place in Athens, Greece, in 1896. It was the beginning of the Modern Olympics.

Since then, many things have changed. Women first competed in the Olympics in 1900. The Olympics were expanded to include winter sports like skiing and figure skating. The "Parallel Olympics" now known as the Paralympics, began to be held for athletes with disabilities.

The modern Olympics aim to bring people from different parts of the world together in peace and encourage friendship among nations. Game on!
